Library Cards

A Wood Buffalo Regional Library (WBRL) card is free for residents who provide proof of address for the Regional Municipality of Wood Buffalo. A card is also free for Alberta’s Indigenous On-Reserve or Metis Settlement residents.

Cards are issued per the rules and regulations established in the Regional Municipality of Wood Buffalo Library Board Safety and Use Bylaw.

Cardholders must report loss or theft of a card immediately to WBRL. The cardholder is responsible for all library materials borrowed and all charges attributable before the loss or theft is reported.

Use of Library Material

Valid WBRL cardholders may borrow circulating library materials, excluding any materials designated for in library use only. The cardholder must be present or have given prior approval for others to use their account.

No person will remove any item from the Library until the item has been checked out to a library card. Loan periods and limits, penalty provisions, and fees are carried out per the Regional Municipality of Wood Buffalo Library Board Safety and Use Bylaw.
